Use this form to claim tax relief on all general medical expenses which are not covered by the state or by private health insurance. You can only claim for medical expenses if you have receipts to prove your claim.

VARICELLA (chicken pox vaccine)

The varicella vaccine requires two vaccinations, with 4 to 6 weeks between each vaccine. To arrange this appointment please make an appointment with your GP for consultation prior to making the appointment with the practice nurse for the vaccination to be given. Please note GP and Nurse appointments can be made on the same day. Child must be over a year old.

ECG

Electrical tracing of the heart to assist diagnosis of heart conditions.



24 Hour BP Monitoring

The practice can provide portable medical equipment that will monitor blood pressures at regular intervals over 24 hours. A prior GP consultation is required.



Ear Irrigation

Ear irrigation is a routine procedure used to remove excess earwax, called cerumen, or foreign materials from the ear.



Spirometry & Nebulisers

- Full lung function testing.
- Inhaled treatment for acute asthma.



Haematology

Full comprehensive blood testing. Appointments to be made for weekday mornings. In order to make an appointment a prior consultation with your GP will be required.



Minor Surgery

All surgery requires a presurgical assessment consultation.

Cryotherapy

Cryotherapy involves removal of skin lesions including warts, verrucae, solar skin damage & skin tags by freezing with liquid nitrogen. Appointments for cryosurgery can be made with any doctor. In some cases it will not be appropriate to use cryotherapy, depending on the diagnosis and the patient's age especially in young children

Diabetes Watch

The Diabetes Watch Clinic is run by our Practice Nurse and monitors patients who have been diagnosed with diabetes. Nurse Lita Griffin organizes the HSE Diabetes Shared Care services to hold clinics within our facility to look after our patients. Once accepted into the programme there will be no charge for this service.

Heart Watch Programme

Our Practice Nurse and Dr. Conor O'Toole run the Heart watch Programme. The Programme monitors patients who have been diagnosed with heart disease.
